# 5. Religious Studies for international Students

A specialized six-year Arabic curriculum has been designed for international students, focusing on Islamic studies. Upon completion, students receive the Daura-e-Hadith/Aalamia degree (MA equivalent), recognized by Pakistan's Higher Education Commission. Our International Department has enrolled students from 73 countries, currently studying or having completed their education. Details follow:

## 6. Quraan Instruction and Hifz (Memorization) For International Students

Special arrangements for Quran memorization, related courses like reading Naziraa), and rules of recitation (tajweed) have been put in place for international students. Emphasis is placed on tajweed, which is taught by renowned recitation experts (quran). Memorization does not get in the way of other school studies which continue simultaneously.



#### 7. Arabic Course for Huffazz

A special Arabic course has been designed for Quran memorizers (huffaaz). The curriculum consists of Quranic Arabic, Arabic grammar, reading and comprehension, selected hadiths, and prayers. Students become competent to be able to translate the Quran. The medium of instruction is Arabic which helps students become fluent in spoken Arabic. After successful completion of this course, students are admitted directly to the 9th grade of the regular school curriculum. During their matriculation, these students can complete the darja aula, the first year of the course, simultaneously.

## 8. Binoria Online Academy

JBA has an online teaching facility for students who are unable to take regular courses because of a professional engagement or other inabilities. Courses include:

- 2. One-Year course for adult
- 3. Two-Year Tafseer course
- 4. Especially designed course for female

## 9. Special Curriculum for Children

A course has also been designed for the grooming and spiritual development of the children at Binoria which includes

- 1. Nurani Qaeda ma' Ifadaat Halimiya
- 2. Quran (memorization and recitation)
- 3. Creed
- 4. Worship rituals
- 5. Selected Quranic verses with brief
- 6. Explanations

- 7. Selected hadith literature
- 8. Sunnah supplications
- 9. Seerah (life of the Prophet 👜)
- 10. Ethics
- 11. Islamic way of life
- 12. Arabic language

Under this institution, such preachers are provided by JBA, who provide teaching of the Quran and Hadith and impart basic religious awareness in mosques located in nearby factories.

Courses designed keeping the subjects above in view are:

- 1. Course for Children
- 2. Nazira (Quran reading) for Children
- 3. One-year course for adult students
- 4. Special course for women

#### **Objectives**

- 1. To impart the quality teaching of the Holy Quran
- 2. To provide religious education easily to boys and girls engaged in contemporary education
- To disseminate the science of Islam in a short time in a simple and easy-to-understand style
- 4. To give intellectual and practical training to the new generation in the light of the Prophet's life
- 5. To create an ideal society equipped with Islamic manners and morals
- 6. To provide familiarity with the Arabic language to the new generation with dedication

## 10. Dar-ul-Quraan

#### Memorization of the Quraan (National Students)

#### 1. Nazira

Children from seven years of age and upwards are admitted to this course. The syllabus includes the traditional nurani queda, recitation of the Quran with principles of tajweed, daily supplications, basic figh rulings, and etiquette.

Children are taught primary school education simultaneously for which they are accredited. Hostel facilities are also available.

#### 2. Memorisation of the Quran

Eleven-year-old children are admitted for memorization. These are children who can recite the Quran with the rules of tajweed and have had a primary school education. Students are made to memorize the Quran and be taught essential figh rulings.

Students also memorize selected hadiths. School education is also continued along with memorization up to matriculation and students take part in Matriculate board examinations. Children have separate hostels along with all other facilities.





#### 3. Tajweed and Recitation

#### Girdaan with Tajweed, Mutashabihaat and Accent

A very important division for the teaching of the Quran, a complete gardaan of the Quran along with tajweed rules is undertaken. Exercises for one para are conducted initially, which has expert Quran reciters who correct mistakes of tajweed, lahan khafee, and lahan jalee and thus teach the correct recitation. Furthermore, the mutashabihat is pointed out to students who are taught the methods for memorizing them.

Following a thorough exercise of the first para in the way described, the rest of the Quran is completed in like manner. This is then followed by exercises in haddar (fluent reading) during the gardaan of the Quran and students are made to adopt Hijazi Arabic accents through training with fluent instructors. Classical books like the jamal al-Qur'an, fawaid makiyya and muqdamah al-jazria are part of the syllabus.

#### Special figh Course for Huffaaz (Quran Memorizers)

In addition to tarawih prayers and duties of imam for regular prayers, certified huffaaz have the occasion to lead Friday prayers. This course caters to the need for such huffaaz to have essential knowledge of fiqh concerning important and basic issues of ibadaat (rituals) which makes them eligible for such duties.
